The Minnesota Wild and Iowa Heartlanders affiliation is entering its fifth season in 2025-26 and the teams have been affiliated since the Heartlanders' inception. Over the first four seasons of the affiliation, 43 former Heartlanders advanced to play in the AHL for the Iowa Wild, including the development of multiple players signed to NHL contracts by the Wild. In the first season of the affiliation, goaltender Hunter Jones became the first player to make it from the Heartlanders to Minnesota (taxi squad). Jones then made Minnesota's 2023 Stanley Cup Playoffs roster, serving as the third goaltender. The Wild have had a long history of advancing players from the ECHL to the NHL, as 38 former ECHL players have skated for Minnesota in the team's 23-season history (as of October 2025). The Wild have made the Stanley Cup Playoffs in five of the last six seasons and 11 times over the last 13.
