TODAY - Wichita continues their franchise long 12-game road trip tonight with the first of two against the Steelheads. The two teams have met six times this season, all in the Air Capitol, with the Thunder holding a 3-2-0-1 record. Wichita sits fifth place in the Mountain Division with 50 points, seven back of fourth place Tahoe. Despite dropping four of their last five, Idaho remains comfortably in second place with 70 points, 11 ahead of Allen in third. **Matt Davis'** 0.931 save percentage is second in the league while **Noah Beck** leads rookies in assists (31). The Steelheads are second in goals per game and average the most penalty minutes per game (16.73). Liam Malmquist (35) and Kaleb Pearson (34) are both top ten in rookie scoring.

Led by a stellar performance from **Matt Davis** (42 saves), Wichita held Kansas City scoreless through regulation despite being outshot 37-18. After not converting on their two third period power plays, Wichita gave Kansas City a power play in overtime. On the man advantage, Bobo Carpenter scored the game winner, his 12th of the year.

HEAD-TO-HEAD - This is the seventh of eight meetings this season between the two clubs and the first of two in Idaho. Wichita is 3-2-0-1 against Idaho this season. All time, the Thunder are 19-19-8 against the Steelheads and 4-10-4 on the road.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN - Wichita began a franchise record 12-game road trip this past week, going 3-0 in its first week. The Thunder lost on Wednesday night at Iowa, 6-3. Wichita followed that up with a 4-3 loss on Friday to Kansas City and an overtime loss at Cable Dahmer Arena on Saturday night, 1-0. The 12-game, six-city excursion will bring them over 7,000 miles in 27 days, surpassing the 2017-18 team that was away from the Air Capitol for eight games. Thunder are 7-12-1-0 on the road this season.

MOVIN' ON UP - **Michal Stinil** moved into sole possession of sixth place in goals scored (115) in team history on Wednesday. He had his four-game point streak snapped on Saturday, giving him six (4-2--6) in his last five games. He needs just two more goals to tie Joe Blaznek (117, 2003-07) for fifth all time.

THREE IS COMPANY - **Jay Dickman** played in his 400th regular season Thunder game on Wednesday. He is just the third player in team history to reach that mark, joining Jason Duda (730) and current assistant coach **Travis Clayton** (696). Dickman needs two points to give him 40 for the sixth consecutive season.

RIISING TO THE BATES - **Peter Bates** had his team-best seven-game point streak snapped on Saturday. His nine points (3-6--9) in that span have catapulted him to 12th in the league in that category. The Thunder captain needs eight goals to reach 100 in his ECHL career.

SHINING STAR - **Matt Davis** was the best player on the ice on Saturday, stopping 42 shots in an overtime loss at Kansas City. Davis has seen 40 or more shots in back-to-back games and a total of six times this year. He is second in the league in save percentage (.931) and 18th with a 2.49 GAA.

THUNDERBOLTS - **Matt Crasa** has 10 points in 24 games since coming to Wichita...**T.J. Lloyd** scored his first of the season last Friday...**Noah Beck** has points in six of his last eight (1-8--9), is fifth in the league in power-play points (21), and **leads** rookies in assists (31)...**Christophe Fillion** scored his first Thunder goal on Wednesday...Wichita sits fifth in fewest penalty minutes per game (9.76)...Wichita 15-2-1-1 when leading after two...Wichita is 15-7-2-2 when scoring first.

STEELHEAD NOTES - The league's leading goal scorer, **Bendan Hoffman** (32-19--51) remains on a PTO with San Jose (AHL)...**Liam Malmquist** (35) and **Kaleb Pearson** (34) are sixth and eighth in rookie scoring respectively...The Steelheads average 16.73 PIM/game, the most in the league...Idaho is 22-3-2-0 when scoring first...The team averages a league-best 34.77 shots per game.

AROUND THE ECHL - There are seven other games in the ECHL tonight. Adirondak duels Reading, Norfolk confronts Greensboro, Wheeling encounters Fort Wayne, Cincinnati engages Toledo, Iowa clashes with Bloomington, Allen travels to Kansas City, and Tahoe visits Utah.

UP NEXT - Wichita and Idaho will finish the season series on Saturday at 8:10 p.m.

BRUCE RAMSAY

HEAD COACH

Ramsay enters his seventh year behind the Thunder bench with a record of 193-179-44-5. Named to the position on May 15, 2019, Ramsay became the winningest head coach in the franchise's history with a 2-1 win over Florida on Oct. 29, 2025, surpassing Kevin McClelland's tally of 194. He also recorded his 200th win at the Wichita helm Nov. 29, 2025 with a 5-1 victory over Kansas City. In 2020-21, he led the Thunder to their second-ever trip to the Kelly Cup Playoffs while receiving the John Brophy Award as ECHL Coach of the Year, as well as being named the ECHL General Manager of the Year.

Ramsay, 56, returned to the ECHL after spending three seasons as an assistant with the AHL's Grand Rapids Griffins. Before that, he was the bench boss of the Tulsa Oilers from 2009-15, where he compiled a 185-180-35 record and led the Oilers to the playoffs in each of his last two seasons in Tulsa - which coincided with Oilers' final season in the Central Hockey League and their first season in the ECHL.

A native of Dryden, Ontario, Ramsay returns to a place that he called home during his playing career. He played for the Thunder during the 2000-01 season, recording 35 points (11-24--35) and compiling 364 penalty minutes. Over his 12-year playing career, he was a part of eight championship teams, winning four Colonial Cups and two Royal Bank Cups. He finished with 245 points (74-171--245) and 3,432 penalty minutes in 677 games as a pro.

After his playing career ended in 2005, he was named the Head Coach of the ACHL's St. Pete/Winston-Salem Parrots. His head coaching career spans 11 seasons, including stints with the Port Huron Beacons (2002-04), Muskegon Fury (2004-08), Muskegon Lumberjacks and the Oilers. Ramsay has consistently led his teams to the postseason, making the playoffs eight out of 11 years. In 2015, Ramsay stepped down from the Oilers to pursue an assistant coaching position with Grand Rapids and helped lead them to the 2017 Calder Cup title.

Clayton, 49, is in his second season behind the bench in Wichita. The Paradise Hill, Saskatchewan native began coaching with the Western States Hockey League's Dallas Snipers in 2012-13. Clayton transitioned back to Canada, where he took the helm of the Lloydminster Bobcats U18 AAA for three seasons. His most recent role was with the Alberta Junior Hockey League's Whitecourt Wolverines during the 2021-22 year.

During his playing career, Clayton spent 11 seasons in the Air Capital. He finished his career with the Bossier-Shreveport Mudbugs from 2009-10 to 2010-11. Clayton won his first President's Cup Trophy with the Mudbugs during the 2010-11 season, tallying 13 points (3g, 10a) in 21 playoff games.

Clayton was one of the faces of the franchise during his time in Wichita. He is near the top of every single offensive category in team history, sitting second in goals (326), second in assists (508), second in points (834), second in games played (696), first in power play goals (110), second in penalty minutes (1,063), first in shorthanded goals (26), first in game-winning goals (50) and first in plus/minus (+108).

He finished his playing career with 983 points (382-601--983) in 880 Central Hockey League games.


Clayton and his wife, Toby, have two sons, Rhys and Jayce.






