Last Game Summary

- Tulsa started off quickly, finding the back of the net three straight times in the first period for a 3-0 lead.
- The Oilers struck first in the second period, but **BoBo Carpenter** responded with his first goal of the season on the Power-Play, assisted by **Marcus Crawford**.
- **Luke Loheit** tallied his second of the season just 5:18 into the third period, with assists coming from **Luke LaMaster** and **Nolan Sullivan**.
- **Jackson Jutting** netted the Mavericks first Short-Handed goal of the season, assisted by **Jack Randl** and **Hudson Wilson**, bringing the Mavericks within one and capping off a strong late-game push that fell just short in a 4-3 final.

Mavericks Hot Streaks

- **Jackson Jutting** is on a five-game point (6) streak.
- **Marcus Crawford** is on a four-game point (5) and three-game assist (4) streak.
- **Jack Randl** is on a three-game point (6) streak.
- The **Mavericks Penalty-Kill** leads the ECHL killing off 17/18 penalties

Beyond the Box Score

- **Jack Randl** became the first Mavericks player this season to earn ECHL Honors, being named ECHL Player of the Week.
- **Logan Terness** made his professional debut on Saturday against the Oilers, stopping 28 shots – the most by a Mavericks goaltender in a single game this season.
- The **Mavericks** are 4-0 when scoring first this season.
- The **Mavericks** are set to play their second “Kids Day Game” of the season on Tuesday, the second of four scheduled this year.

Scouting the Steelheads

- Forward, **Brendan Hoffmann** leads the Steelheads in points with eight.
- Rookie, **Tommy Bergsland** is tied for second in points among defenseman in the ECHL.
- Idaho ranks third in the ECHL with 28 goals this season.
