TODAY - Wichita continues its four-game homestand tonight with the first meeting of the season against Idaho. Both teams come into tonight's contest on winning streaks. The Steelheads have won four in a row after sweeping Trois-Rivieres last weekend. The Thunder have won their last three after taking both games against Tulsa on Friday and Saturday. Idaho is tied for the division lead in the Mountain with 30 points. Wichita is alone in fifth place with 21. The Steelheads have played three more games than the Thunder. Brendan Hoffman leads Idaho with 19 points. Liam Malmquist is second with 17. Noah Beck leads Wichita with 18 points. Kyle Crnkovic is second with 17.

HEAD-TO-HEAD - This is the first meeting of the season between the Thunder and the Steelheads. Alltime, Wichita is 16-14-7 vs. Idaho and 12-4-3 at home against the Steelheads.

HEATER - Kyle Crnkovic has been on a tear for the Thunder. He recorded two goals in both games this past weekend against Tulsa. Crnkovic has at least two points in four of his last five outings.

**MILESTONES –** Jay Dickman is nearing two more milestones. He's five assists shy of 200 for his ECHL career. Dickman is also nearing 400 ECHL games, currently at 384.

BATES MOTEL - Peter Bates is also nearing a few milestones. He is close to 200 ECHL goals and 200 ECHL points. Bates has points in three-straight games.

SUN DEVIL - Noah Beck had another solid week for the Thunder. He has four assists in his last three games. The former Arizona Sun Devil leads the team with 18 points. Beck is third in rookie scoring, third among rookies with 13 helpers, tied for first among rookies with seven power play assists and 10 power play points.

FIRST - Tian Rask had one of his best games as a pro last Saturday night. The rookie forward from Saskatoon, Saskatchewan tallied his first pro point with an assist on the game's opening goal and also named as the Great Clips Glass Rattler.

IDAHO NOTES - Sam Jardine earned his 100th ECHL point last Wednesday...Jade Miller skated in his 200th Steelheads game on December 6...Liam Malmquist recorded his first career hat trick last Friday against Trois-Rivieres...Everett Sheen hit the triple crown of milestones last week, now leading in wins by an Idaho coach (218), most games coached for the Steelheads (361) and first in team history across the WCHL and ECHL era (229)...





#### BRUCE RAMSAY HEAD COACH

Ramsay enters his seventh year behind the Thunder bench with a record of 193-179-44-5. Named to the position on May 15, 2019, Ramsay became the winningest head coach in the franchise's history with a 2-1 win over Florida on Oct. 29, 2025, surpassing Kevin McClelland's tally of 194. He also recorded his 200th win at the Wichita helm Nov. 29, 2025 with a 5-1 victory over Kansas City. In 2020-21, he led the Thunder to their second-ever trip to the Kelly Cup Playoffs while receiving the John Brophy Award as ECHL Coach of the Year, as well as being named the ECHL General Manager of the Year.

Ramsay, 56, returned to the ECHL after spending three seasons as an assistant with the AHL's Grand Rapids Griffins. Before that, he was the bench boss of the Tulsa Oilers from 2009-15, where he compiled a 185-180-35 record and led the Oilers to the playoffs in each of his last two seasons in Tulsa - which coincided with Oilers' final season in the Central Hockey League and their first season in the ECHL.

A native of Dryden, Ontario, Ramsay returns to a place that he called home during his playing career. He played for the Thunder during the 2000-01 season, recording 35 points (11-24--35) and compiling 364 penalty minutes. Over his 12-year playing career, he was a part of eight championship teams, winning four Colonial Cups and two Royal Bank Cups. He finished with 245 points (74-171--245) and 3,432 penalty minutes in 677 games as a pro.

After his playing career ended in 2005, he was named the Head Coach of the ACHL's St. Pete/Winston-Salem Parrots. His head coaching career spans 11 seasons, including stints with the Port Hunron Beacons (2002-04), Muskegon Fury (2004-08), Muskegon Lumberjacks and the Oilers. Ramsay has consistently led his teams to the postseason, making the playoffs eight out of 11 years. In 2015, Ramsay stepped down from the Oilers

## TRAVIS CLAYTON ASSISTANT COACH

Clayton, 49, is in his second season behind the bench in Wichita. The Paradise Hill, Saskatchewan native began coaching with the Western States Hockey League's Dallas Snipers in 2012-13.
