Greensboro Gargoyles Coaching Staff

Scott Burt - Head Coach

Mackenzie, BC - Seattle Thunderbirds, Swift Current Broncos, Edmonton Ice, Red Deer Rebels (WHL)

The inaugural head coach in Greensboro Gargoyles history, brings over a decade of coaching experience and one of the most decorated playing careers in the ECHL to the Gate City.

He joins the Gargoyles following four seasons as head coach and general manager of the Rapid City Rush, where he guided the team to back-to-back postseason appearances and established a culture built on work ethic and community connection.

Prior to his time in Rapid City, Burt served as an assistant coach in the Western Hockey League with the Spokane Chiefs from 2013 to 2019, and previously spent time behind ECHL benches in Idaho and Alaska developing players at the professional level.

Before transitioning to coaching, Burt played 13 professional seasons as a forward, appearing in 586 ECHL games and totaling 356 points (149 G, 207 A). He is a three-time Kelly Cup Champion and appeared in six Kelly Cup Finals, capturing titles with both the Idaho Steelheads and Alaska Aces.

Known for his leadership and physical presence, Burt's impact in Boise was immortalized when the Steelheads retired his No. 12 jersey one of the highest honors in the organization's history.

A proud son of a Royal Canadian Mounted Police officer, Burt has carried his community-first values throughout his career and is recognized for his perseverance off the ice after overcoming a brain tumor during his coaching tenure.

He now brings that same determination and championship pedigree to Greensboro as he builds the foundation for the Gargoyles' inaugural ECHL season.

Jason Binkley - Assistant Coach

Powell, OH - Ferris State (NCAA), South Carolina Stingrays, Utah Grizzlies, Cincinnati Cyclones, Fort Wayne Komets (ECHL)

The inaugural assistant coach in Greensboro Gargoyles history, brings four years of professional coaching experience and a six-year playing career to the organization. He joins the Gargoyles after serving as Head Coach of the Reading Royals (ECHL), where he guided the club to a playoff berth in 2024 and earned 46 career coaching victories. Binkley initially joined the Royals as an assistant coach for the 2022-23 season before being promoted to interim head coach midway through the following campaign, later being named the full-time head coach that summer.

Prior to his time in Reading, Binkley served as an assistant coach with the Fayetteville Marksmen (SPHL) during the 2021-22 season. That year, he helped steer the team to the most successful campaign in its 20-year history, finishing with a 40-12-0-2 record. Before beginning his coaching career, Binkley played collegiately at Ferris State University, where he appeared in the 2012 Frozen Four championship game and compiled 68 points (6 G, 62 A) across four seasons. He was awarded Ferris State's Presidents Award as the university's top student-athlete during his sophomore year and earned NCAA All-Academic honors as a senior.

Following his college career, Binkley played six professional seasons, debuting in the ECHL with the South Carolina Stingrays in 2015 and later suiting up for the Utah Grizzlies, Cincinnati Cyclones, and Fort Wayne Komets, in addition to a stint overseas. A dependable, two-way defenseman, he totaled 341 ECHL games, registering 28 goals and 113 assists for 141 points. Binkley was a key contributor to consecutive deep playoff runs with Fort Wayne in 2017 and 2018 and was recognized with the Komets Unsung Hero Award in 2018 for his leadership and dedication. He concluded his playing career with the Jacksonville Icemen during the 2020-21 season. Now in Greensboro, Binkley joins Head Coach Scott Burt in leading the Gargoyles into their inaugural ECHL season, bringing with him a modern perspective on player development, strong leadership qualities, and a deep understanding of the league.
