#### Last Game Summary

- Both netminders came out strong in the first period, turning aside every shot they faced to keep the game scoreless heading into the second.
- **Bobo Carpenter** broke the deadlock late in the second period, finishing a tic-tac-toe passing play set up by **Lucas Sowder** and **Luke Loheit** to give the Mavericks a 1-0 lead entering the final frame.
- **David Cotton** extended the Mavericks lead early in the third with a one-timer off feeds from **Casey Carreau** and **Colby McArthur**. Less than a minute later, **Sowder** added another goal, assisted by **Loheit**, which stood as the final tally in a 3-0 Mavericks victory.
- **Jack LaFontaine** was a brick wall in net, stopping all 24 shots he faced to earn his fourth shutout of the season.
