GAME OVERVIEW

The Admirals earned the come-from-behind victory over the Greensboro Gargoyles on Saturday to conclude their three-game series. Tonight, Norfolk welcomes in the Mountain Division's Idaho Steelheads for a three-game homestand at Scope Arena. Idaho sits 2nd in the division, 3rd in the Western Conference, and 5th overall in the ECHL. Brendan Hoffmann leads the way for the Steelheads with 51 total points (32 goals, 19 assists) and is 6th in the league in points.

Norfolk snapped their three-game losing streak as Brandon Osmundson was back in the lineup following his suspension earned against Fort Wayne and he brought a noticeable energy boost to the team. After tonight, Norfolk will only have 20 games remaining in the regular season as they sit 19 points (9.5 games) out of the playoffs. If the Admirals can earn points against a top team in the Western Conference this week, they can set themselves up for a late push to make the Kelly Cup Playoffs for the third consecutive season.

Head Coach & General Manager | 4th season

Hometown: Eagle River, Wisconsin (USA)

Hired: August 11, 2022 (As Assistant Coach) | Named Head Coach on November 7, 2022



Bio: Carr enters his third full season as the Admirals' Head Coach and General Manager. Last season, he led the Admirals to their second-straight North-Division Finals where the Admirals were eliminated by the eventual Kelly Cup Champion Trois-Rivières Lions. Carr's first full season as Head Coach and GM in the 2023-24 season saw a 42-point difference from the 2022-23 season when he took over for Rod Taylor.

Carr began his coaching career in 2012-13 as an assistant coach with the WSHL's Salt Lake City Moose. He eventually became the head coach and led the Moose to playoff berths for the next two seasons. Carr was named the assistant coach of the ECHL's Utah Grizzlies in 2016-17. One year later, he was named the head coach of the SPHL's Knoxville Ice Bears.

Carr spent five seasons in Knoxville, becoming one of the most successful coaches in professional hockey. He was named the 2021-22 Coach of the Year after leading the Ice Bears to a 42-10-8 regular season record, which was the franchise's first regular season title since 2009. Those 42 wins also set an all-time league record. In five seasons under Carr's stewardship, the Ice Bears combined record was 151-83-24.

In August 2022, Carr took the next step in his coaching career and was named the Norfolk Admirals assistant coach. Three months later, he was named the new head coach. Carr coached his 100th game with the Admirals on January 19, 2024 against then Newfoundland Growlers. He won his 200th professional game as a head coach on March 23, 2024 against the Adirondack Thunder. Carr coached in his 200th game as the head bench boss for Norfolk on April 4, 2025 against the Iowa Heartlanders.



Bio: D'Alimonte was hired as the Assistant Coach on July 8, 2025. D'Alimonte spent the previous five seasons with the Pittsburgh Penguins organization, including the last three as the club's Assistant Video Coach. During that time, he also served as an Assistant Coach for the Wheeling Nailers during back-to-back ECHL playoff runs in 2024 and 2025. Prior to joining the professional ranks, D'Alimonte held video coaching roles in the Ontario Hockey League with the Soo Greyhounds and Mississauga Steelheads. A graduate of York University, he began his coaching career with the York Lions men's hockey program, helping the team capture the OUA Queen's Cup Championship in 2017.



Thomas Skelton

Goalie Consultant | 2nd Season

Bio: Skelton is in his second year as the Goaltending Consultant with the Admirals. Previously, Skelton was the Associate Coach and Assistant GM of the Fernie Ghostriders in the KIJHL and also served as a Pre-Scout Consultant for the Coquitlam Express of the BCHL, while also serving as the Goaltending Coach for the University of Oregon Ducks men's hockey team. Previous to coaching, Skelton played Junior and university hockey in Saskatchewan.
