Josh Atkinson scored and assisted twice, John Parker-Jones notched the game-winner and empty-netter, and Keaton Mastrodonato fired home a power play goal to power the Greenville Swamp Rabbits to a 6-3 win over the Utah Grizzlies on Saturday night. The win gives the Swamp Rabbits four straight, and a sweep of their three-game set at Utah.

NOTES AND NUMBERS

•**CONNECT FOUR:** The Swamp Rabbits most recent win gives them their fourth consecutive entering the second week of their current road trip. This feat ties the longest such streak this season, matching four straight victories from October 31st against Orlando to November 8th against Orlando.

•**STREET SWEEPERS:** Of course, the win streak is vastly in part to the first three-game sweep of the season for the Swamp Rabbits, who took care of business against Utah with 3-1, 3-2 (OT), and 6-3 wins last week. It's the first time the Swamp Rabbits have earned a three-game sweep since April 7-10, 2022, against the Rapid City Rush. They've claimed points or wins in two or better in the three games in five series since then.

•***AT* A BOY!:** Swamp Rabbits captain JOSH ATKINSON had a night to remember in the anchor game against Utah. Starting off all scoring entries at 5:59 of the first, Atkinson parlayed that start to an eventual ECHL career-high four-point night, finishing with both a pair of goals and assists. He now leads the Swamp Rabbits in scoring for d-men with 22 points, and assists on the whole roster with 16.

•**REVENGE IS A DISH BEST SERVED COLD:** Swamp Rabbits forward KEATON MASTRODONATO completed the first week of his two week trip down memory lane with a point in each game (totaling four with a apir of goals and assists) against the Grizzlies, where he earned a career-high 30 assists and 49 points. The season prior as a rookie, he suited up with the Idaho Steelheads, his current opponent, and tallied a career-high 24 goals as part of 42 points in 48 games. Additionally, current forward WADE MURPHY and defensemen JAKE MURRY also suited up with Idaho that same season, with Murray earning 10 points in 26 games and Murphy smashing career-highs with 25 goals, 41 assists, and 66 points.

•**DON'T TAKE *OFFENSE*:** The Swamp Rabbits offense in this win streak has come in a variety of ways, whether it's the power play (27.7%, 5/18), or in the second period (8 of 16 goals) to name some. But most importantly, it's been consistent. The Swamp Rabbits have goals in eight of their last 12 periods in this stretch.

•**NICE TO MEET YOU:** This meeting tonight is the first one ever between the Steelheads and the Swamp Rabbits. It's their second of three first meetings on the year, with Greensboro (11/26, 8-1 W) coming prior, and Bloomington still to come April 9th, 11th, and 12th. After tonight, the Swamp Rabbits will have only not played Iowa and Tahoe in their team's history.

•**WE'RE GOING STREAKING!:** Two players carry a streak into tonight's opener against Idaho:

- JOSH ATKINSON: has assists + points in four straight games (2-5=7; 1/23 vs FLA - 1/31 @ UT)
- KEATON MASTRODONATO: has points in three straight games (2-2=4; 1/28 @ UT - 1/31 @ UT)

CHAD COSTELLO - HEAD COACH/GENERAL MANAGER

Johnston, Iowa - Northeastern (NCAA)/Cedar Rapids, Des Moines (USHL)/Wichita Falls (NAHL)

Costello comes to the Upstate to begin his third season as a Head Coach, and his fourth behind a bench in professional hockey. Previously, he was appointed Associate Coach of the Rapid City Rush on December 12th, leading the team to an 18-10-3-1 record while averaging 3.63 goals per game in that span. His efforts helped the Rush finish the season just shy of 20.0% on the power play and propelled the team to eventual ECHL franchise records with an 11-game winning streak and overall 13-game point streak from February 1st to March 1st. That torrid run included sweeps of the Utah Grizzlies and Maine Mariners, and two of the Idaho Steelheads.

Prior to joining the Rush, Costello was the Head Coach and General Manager of the Allen Americans for a pair of seasons (2022-24), reaching the Kelly Cup Playoffs in both campaigns while compiling a 70-67-5-2 record in 144 contests. In his first season, his Americans squad finished second in the Mountain Division, top-five in both power play and penalty kill, and top-10 in the ECHL offensively. Additionally, his team featured three of the league's top-10 scorers, including eventual ECHL MVP and Rookie of the Year Hank Crone, who led the league with 105 points, trailed next by teammate Jack Combs' 95-point total.

A native of Johnston, Iowa, Costello, 38, turned to coaching following a 14-year playing career, the majority of which was played in the ECHL where he cemented himself as one of the best players in the 38-year history of the "Premiere 'AA' Hockey League". The 5'9", 185-pound forward notched a scorching 561 points (172g-389ast) in 375 games as a member of the Allen Americans (2014-17, 2021-22), Ontario Reign (2013-14), Colorado Eagles (2011-13), and Texas Wildcatters (2008), the latter of which he turned professional with following college. While he garnered ECHL First-Team All-Star and MVP honors with Colorado in 2012, he is best known for his work with Allen, where he was the captain for three of his four seasons. Costello won three consecutive ECHL scoring titles, each with 100-plus-point seasons from 2015-17, back-to-back Kelly Cup Championships in 2015 and 2016, June M. Kelly Playoff MVP honors for the latter, back-to-back ECHL MVP recognitions in 2016 and 2017, and four ECHL All-Star Team Selections (1st Team in 2015, 2016, 2017; 2nd Team in 2022). His #13 was retired by the Allen Americans on March 23, 2024.

In total, Costello played 749 professional games across the ECHL, AHL, IHL, and CHL in North America, the DEL in Germany, and Norway, earning 919 points (293g-626ast). Before turning pro, he played two college seasons with Northeastern University in the NCAA, two USHL seasons with the Cedar Rapids Roughriders and Des Moines Buccaneers, and one NAHL season with the Wichita Falls Wildcats.

JASON PAYNE - ASSOCIATE COACH

Toronto, Ontario - Barrie/London (OHL)

Payne comes to the Upstate after spending the last six seasons with the Cincinnati Cyclones, serving as Head Coach over the previous four campaigns. While with the Toronto Maple Leafs ECHL affiliate, he compiled a 143-114-31 record in 288 games for a career 0.550 win percentage. In the 2022-23 season, Payne lead the Cyclones to a 47-16-6-3 record and 103 points, the second most points in the entire ECHL, earning the privilege to coach the 2023 Western Conference All-Stars and culminating in the 2023 Central Division Championship.

Previous to his appointment as the Cyclones bench boss, he was an Assistant Coach for the team under Matt Thomas for a pair of seasons. In his six seasons in Cincinnati, he qualified for the postseason three times, twice as head coach, making it as far as the Central Division Finals in 2023.

Payne, 49, immediately jumped into the coaching ranks following his playing career, taking various roles in the OHL and OJHL including scout, skating and skills coach, and General Manager. As a player, the 6'1", 190-pound forward played 14 seasons professionally, amassing 32 goals, 44 assists, 76 points, and 1,825 PIM in 522 games across the AHL, ECHL, IHL, UHL, and LNAH, winning the 2005 LNAH title with Quebec RadioX. Before playing professionally, the Toronto, Ontario, native played two seasons in the OHL with the Barrie Colts and London Knights.
