Keaton Mastrodonato pocketed his second goal of the game 95 seconds into overtime, spearheading four multi-point efforts to an eventual win for the Greenville Swamp Rabbits, 5-4 over the Idaho Steelheads on Friday night in game two of their three-game set. The win forces a rubber match for the series and road trip finale Saturday night, and extends the team's point streak to six games (5-0-0-1).

#### NOTES AND NUMBERS

•**SIX OF ONE, HALF DOZEN OF THE OTHER:** Wanting both points this time around, the Swamp Rabbits did just that: thanks to KEATON MASTRODONATO'S second goal at 1:35 of overtime, the Swamp Rabbits got back in the win column, and in doing so, extended their season-high point streak to six straight games. The last time the Swamp Rabbits had a point streak longer than five games came all the way back in their 2024 South Division Championship campaign when they won eight straight games from November 14th to December 1st. The Swamp Rabbits have won five of their last six (5-0-0-1) dating back to January 23rd, and have 9 of 10 points coming into the finale tonight.

•**TIME AND A HALF:** After falling in their first three games decided in overtime, the Swamp Rabbits have completely flipped the script. Including last night's 5-4 win, the team has won four of their last five games that end in seven minutes of three-on-three, and each of their last two. Mastrodonato netted his first overtime winner of the season, becoming the third player to notch the second point, joining JACK BRACKETT and RYAN O'HARA, the latter of whom leads the team with a pair of OT winners.

•**ET TU BRUTE?**: Keaton Mastrodonato was just the tip of the iceberg of former Steelheads to stick the dagger in their old team. In addition to Mastrodonato's pair of tallies, WADE MURPHY potted his first goal as a Swamp Rabbit along with two helpers, and PARKER BERGE started the scoring entries for the Swamp Rabbits with his sixth of the year in the first frame. Those three former Steelheads accounted for four of the team's five goals and a pair of assists, exactly half of the team's 14 total points on the scoresheet.

•**WHAT A RELIEF:** One of the more Herculean efforts for the Swamp Rabbits in the win was net-minder MATTIAS SHOLL, who earned his first win of his career while coming in relief. After Isaiah Saville exited the game after 14:55 of his start, Sholl took over for the remaining 46:40 and stopped 29 of 32 shots to secure his team-leading eighth win of the season. The win also happened to be his first past 60 minutes of play, and gives him an 8-7-2-0 record in 19 contests.

•**NOT ON VACATION:** Vacation is a common misconception on road trips, and the Swamp Rabbits have treated them nothing like that. Last night's win was the team's 10th away from the friendly confines of Bon Secours Wellness Arena, accomplished in 20 road games to put them to 10-6-2-1 on the year. Similarly, it took the Swamp Rabbits 21 games last year to hit their 10th, going 10-9-2-0 on February 5th with a shutout win of the Everblades.

•**ANTIQUE PISTOL:** Let's be clear: he's not old, we just said that for the pun. Swamp Rabbits veteran PATRICK POLINO hits a career milestone tonight when he suits up for the 300th time in his professional hockey career. Spanning six seasons between the ECHL and AHL, Polino's 300th comes in his 264th in the "Premier 'AA' Hockey League", where he's accrued 66 goals and 182 points as a member of the Swamp Rabbits, Allen Americans, Adirondack Thunder, and Cincinnati Cyclones. His remaining 36 games have been as a member of the AHL's Rochester Americans and Providence Bruins, adding another five goals and nine points.

### CHAD COSTELLO - HEAD COACH/GENERAL MANAGER

Johnston, Iowa - Northeastern (NCAA)/Cedar Rapids, Des Moines (USHL)/Wichita Falls (NAHL)

Costello comes to the Upstate to begin his third season as a Head Coach, and his fourth behind a bench in professional hockey. Previously, he was appointed Associate Coach of the Rapid City Rush on December 12th, leading the team to an 18-10-3-1 record while averaging 3.63 goals per game in that span. His efforts helped the Rush finish the season just shy of 20.0% on the power play and propelled the team to eventual ECHL franchise records with an 11-game winning streak and overall 13-game point streak from February 1st to March 1st. That torrid run included sweeps of the Utah Grizzlies and Maine Mariners, and two of the Idaho Steelheads.

Prior to joining the Rush, Costello was the Head Coach and General Manager of the Allen Americans for a pair of seasons (2022-24), reaching the Kelly Cup Playoffs in both campaigns while compiling a 70-67-5-2 record in 144 contests. In his first season, his Americans squad finished second in the Mountain Division, top-five in both power play and penalty kill, and top-10 in the ECHL offensively. Additionally, his team featured three of the league's top-10 scorers, including eventual ECHL MVP and Rookie of the Year Hank Crone, who led the league with 105 points, trailed next by teammate Jack Combs' 95-point total.

A native of Johnston, Iowa, Costello, 38, turned to coaching following a 14-year playing career, the majority of which was played in the ECHL where he cemented himself as one of the best players in the 38-year history of the "Premiere 'AA' Hockey League". The 5'9", 185-pound forward notched a scorching 561 points (172g-389ast) in 375 games as a member of the Allen Americans (2014-17, 2021-22), Ontario Reign (2013-14), Colorado Eagles (2011-13), and Texas Wildcatters (2008), the latter of which he turned professional with following college. While he garnered ECHL First-Team All-Star and MVP honors with Colorado in 2012, he is best known for his work with Allen, where he was the captain for three of his four seasons. Costello won three consecutive ECHL scoring titles, each with 100-plus-point seasons from 2015-17, back-to-back Kelly Cup Championships in 2015 and 2016, June M. Kelly Playoff MVP honors for the latter, back-to-back ECHL MVP recognitions in 2016 and 2017, and four ECHL All-Star Team Selections (1st Team in 2015, 2016, 2017; 2nd Team in 2022). His #13 was retired by the Allen Americans on March 23, 2024.

In total, Costello played 749 professional games across the ECHL, AHL, IHL, and CHL in North America, the DEL in Germany, and Norway, earning 919 points (293g-626ast). Before turning pro, he played two college seasons with Northeastern University in the NCAA, two USHL seasons with the Cedar Rapids Roughriders and Des Moines Buccaneers, and one NAHL season with the Wichita Falls Wildcats.

### JASON PAYNE - ASSOCIATE COACH

Toronto, Ontario - Barrie/London (OHL)

Payne comes to the Upstate after spending the last six seasons with the Cincinnati Cyclones, serving as Head Coach over the previous four campaigns. While with the Toronto Maple Leafs ECHL affiliate, he compiled a 143-114-31 record in 288 games for a career 0.550 win percentage. In the 2022-23 season, Payne lead the Cyclones to a 47-16-6-3 record and 103 points, the second most points in the entire ECHL, earning the privilege to coach the 2023 Western Conference All-Stars and culminating in the 2023 Central Division Championship.

Previous to his appointment as the Cyclones bench boss, he was an Assistant Coach for the team under Matt Thomas for a pair of seasons. In his six seasons in Cincinnati, he qualified for the postseason three times, twice as head coach, making it as far as the Central Division Finals in 2023.

Payne, 49, immediately jumped into the coaching ranks following his playing career, taking various roles in the OHL and OJHL including scout, skating and skills coach, and General Manager. As a player, the 6'1", 190-pound forward played 14 seasons professionally, amassing 32 goals, 44 assists, 76 points, and 1,825 PIM in 522 games across the AHL, ECHL, IHL, UHL, and LNAH, winning the 2005 LNAH title with Quebec RadioX. Before playing professionally, the Toronto, Ontario, native played two seasons in the OHL with the Barrie Colts and London Knights.
