**TODAY** – Wichita continues its three-game series this weekend against Idaho. The Thunder fell last night in game one against the Steelheads, 5-2. Wichita opened the scoring early in the first, but conceded five-unanswered and had its two-game win streak snapped. Idaho has points in its last 10 games, going 9-0-1 over that stretch. The Thunder remains in fifth place with 45 points. Idaho is second in the Mountain Division with 68 points. Rapid City knocked off Tahoe last night, moving the Rush just two points back of Wichita. Allen fell in Tulsa, 2-0. Brendan Hoffman leads the Steelheads with 51 points. Liam Malmquist is second with 34. Kyle Crnkovic leads the Thunder with 47 points. Peter Bates is second with 41.

**HEAD-TO-HEAD** – This is the fifth meeting of the season between the Thunder and the Steelheads. All-time, Wichita is 17-16-8 vs. Idaho and 13-6-4 at home against the Steelheads.

**TWO** – Noah Beck recorded his eighth goal of the season last night to open the scoring in the first period. He tallied an assist in the third, adding to his numbers on special teams. Beck is tied for third among rookies with six power play goals and first among rookies with 14 power play assists.

**WELCOME BACK** – Matt Davis returned earlier this week and made an immediate impact on Wednesday. The rookie netminder out of the University of Denver stopped 33 shots to earn his sixth victory of the season. He has wins in back-to-back starts after leaving the game on December 17 with 15 seconds left. He lowered his goals-against to 2.53 and save percentage to .930.

**40** – Peter Bates recorded his sixth power play goal on Wednesday night to go along with his second game-winner of the campaign. He added an assist last night, giving him points in three-straight. The Thunder captain hit the 40-point mark for the fourth-straight season.

**ROAD** – Wichita snapped its road losing skid on Wednesday night. The Thunder had dropped their last five games away from INTRUST Bank Arena dating back to December 17. Wichita has played just four road games since the calendar turned to 2026.

**SHOOTING GALLERY** – Wichita unloaded 43 shots on net last night against Idaho. The Thunder have fired 30 or more shots on net in 16 of their last 17 games. Wichita is fourth in the league in shots for per game, averaging 33.68 shots a contest.
