QUICK HITS

TODAY'S PREVIEW

The South Carolina Stingrays face the Orlando Solar Bears for the third of ten meetings this season. The Stingrays are looking for their first home win of the 2023-24 campaign.

LAST TIME OUT

The Stingrays dropped a 4-2 decision to the Savannah Ghost Pirates on Friday. South Carolina fell into a 3-0 hole in the first period, and their third-period comeback was too little too late. Mitchell Gibson made 22 saves in the loss.

LOOKING TO GAIN GROUND

With a win today South Carolina can pull within one point of Orlando, who currently holds the fourth and final playoff spot in the South Division standings. South Carolina has 10 points and Orlando has 13.

SCOUTING THE SOLAR BEARS

Orlando played last night in Savannah and will host Savannah tomorrow night. It is their first time playing three games in three days this season. The Solar Bears are 2-0 against the Stingrays this season and are 5-0 when being outshot by opponents.

ALL-TIME SERIES

The Stingrays are 63-33-12 against the Solar Bears all time. South Carolina is 12-8-1 at home against Orlando in the last five years.

STRONG PENALTY KILL

The Stingrays have the number one ranked penalty kill in the ECHL with just four power play goals allowed on 35 power play attempts. They'll look to stay out of the box against Orlando today. In each of the previous two meetings the Stingrays took 6 penalties.

POWER PLAY STRUGGLES

The Stingrays have the 24th ranked power play in the ECHL while Orlando has the 26th. South Carolina has gone 1 for 4 on the power play in each of its last two games.

WHO'S HOT

Kevin O'Neil has 3 points in his last two games and leads the Stingrays in points per game (1.00). He has played alongside Austin Magera and Tyson Empey for the last three games.
