QUICK HITS

TODAY'S PREVIEW

The Stingrays will look for their third straight win when they take on the Greenville on Friday night. The Stingrays are 1-1 against Greenville and this will be the final meeting between the two teams in 2023. Both teams have played 22 games this season. Each team has won 13 of the last 26 meetings at the North Charleston Coliseum.

LAST TIME OUT

The Stingrays skated to a 5-3 victory over the Orlando Solar Bears on Tuesday night. Five players scored for the Rays, and Mitchell Gibson made 21 saves in the victory.

SCOUTING THE SWAMP RABBITS

The Swamp Rabbits currently have the best points percentage in the ECHL (0.818) and are in first place in the South Division (36 points). They have the number one road penalty kill in the ECHL (93.1%) and goaltender Ryan Bednard has the third best save percentage in the league. They are 11-1 in one goal games and 11-2 when they are outshot by opponents.

ALL-TIME SERIES

The Stingrays are 94-52-27 against the Swamp Rabbits all time. They are 13-8-5 in the last five years against Greenville at home.

POTENT POWER PLAYS

The Stingrays and Swamp Rabbits have the two best power plays in the South Division. Greenville is sixth in the league and South Carolina is ninth.

STINGRAYS SCORING FIRST

The Stingrays have scored first in four of their last five games. They 11-2 when leading after one period and 10-2 when leading after two periods.

WHO'S HOT

Austin Magera has seven goals in seven games this December. He has scored South Carolina's first goal in 36% of our games. 66% of his goals scored this year have been first goals.

PUCKS ON NET

The Stingrays have outshot their opponents in 16 of their 22 games.

WILKINS AGAINST THE RABBITS

Josh Wilkins scored a hat trick in South Carolina's last matchup against Greenville and has five points (4g,2a) in two games against the Swamp Rabbits.
