BOHLSEN GIVING A BOOST

Stingrays rookie forward Kaden Bohlsen has caught fire over the last four games. The Willmar, Minnesota native has three goals over his last four games and four points after his fourth multi-point game of the season on Thursday in Savannah. Bohlsen has 15 goals this season, which is tied for second on the Stingrays.

ROAD DOGS The Stingrays won seven straight games on the road dating back to December 19th in Orlando before it came to an end on Sunday once again in Orlando. The seven game road win streak is tied for the longest road win streak in the ECHL this season with the Toledo Walleye. South Carolina went 5-0 on the road in the month of January.

WINNING THE CLOSE ONES South Carolina has played in 14 one-goal games this season and are 12-1-1 in those contests, one of the best marks in the ECHL this season. The 12 wins are tied for the fourth most wins in one-goal games in the ECHL while the Stingrays also hold an 8-5-0 record in two-goal games this year. South Carolina has not lost a one-goal game since December 5th.

SIMON KEEPS SCORING Stingrays forward Simon Pinard continues to shine in his first season with South Carolina. Pinard has points in seven straight games and has 11 points (7 goals, 4 assists) over his last ten games. The Drummondville, Quebec native leads the club in goals with 17, and leads the team in assists (27) and points (44). His 44 points has him tied for fifth in the ECHL.

STACKING AGAINST THE DIVISION The Stingrays continue a very South Division heavy schedule this season. South Carolina against the South Division this season is 23-16-1-0, while holding a 4-0 record against the North Division. 60 of South Carolina's 72 games this season are against the South Division. South Carolina's next 12 games come against the South Division.

DAVE WARSOFSKY



David Warsofsky is entering his first season as Head Coach and Director of Hockey Operations for the South Carolina Stingrays. He is the 13th head coach in franchise history. Warsofsky joins the Stingrays following a 14-year professional playing career and most recently served as a special coaching advisor for the Stingrays during the 2024-25 season. The Marshfield, Massachusetts native played 55 NHL games with the Boston Bruins, Pittsburgh Penguins, New Jersey Devils, and Colorado Avalanche. He appeared in 476 American Hockey League games with Providence, Wilkes-Barre/Scranton, San Antonio, Chicago, and Colorado. He captained Team USA at the 2008 U18 World Championship, was an assistant captain for the gold medal-winning 2010 U20 World Junior team. He represented Team USA at the 2022 Winter Olympics in Beijing, serving as an assistant captain. Warsofsky helped Boston University win the 2009 NCAA National Championship and was drafted in the 4th round (95th overall) of the 2008 Draft.

SCOTT DAVIDSON



Assistant Coach

Scott Davidson is entering his third season behind the Stingrays bench as an Assistant Coach. In 2024-25, Davidson oversaw the Stingrays forwards and penalty kill. Under Davidson's leadership, South Carolina's penalty kill finished first in the ECHL at 86.3%. Davidson played 33 games as a forward for the Rays during the 2019-20 season. Davidson started his coaching career at the Maine Nordiques Academy in 2021 before coaching at the Elite Hockey Academy in Guilford, Connecticut, this past year. Davidson played four seasons of Division I hockey at Quinnipiac University, where he was an assistant captain in his junior and senior years. Following the conclusion of his collegiate career, Davidson joined the Charlotte Checkers and was a member of their 2019 Calder Cup championship team.

MIKE HAMILTON



Assistant Coach

Mike Hamilton is entering his second season behind the bench with the Stingrays as an assistant coach. Hamilton's playing career lasted six seasons and he skated in 40 games for the Stingrays. He has lived in Charleston for the majority of his post-playing career and is now beginning his professional coaching career. A native of Victoria, British Columbia, Hamilton was selected by the Atlanta Thrashers in the sixth round of the 2003 NHL Draft. Following a four-year college hockey career at the University of Maine from 2003-2007, Hamilton skated in 305 career professional games split between two AHL teams, four ECHL teams, and professional teams in Italy and Scotland. In 2007-08, Hamilton won a Calder Cup Championship with the AHL's Chicago Wolves.

CHUCK LIEBENROOD



Head Equipment Manager

Chuck Liebenrood is entering the second season of his second stint as the Head Equipment Manager for the Stingrays. Liebenrood grew up in Summerville, SC, and attended Stingrays games as a child. He was in attendance at the North Charleston Coliseum the night the Stingrays won their second Kelly Cup title in 2001. Liebenrood played for the Summerville High School hockey team and graduated in 2010. He began working for the Stingrays as an equipment assistant in the 2011-2012 season and was promoted to Head Equipment Manager ahead of the 2014-15 season at age 22. That season, Liebenrood helped the Stingrays reach the 2015 Kelly Cup Finals, where they fell to the Allen Americans in seven games.
