I SAW A GHOST (PIRATE) The Stingrays suffered their first loss of the 2025-26 season on Thursday night, 9-4, against Savannah at Enmarket Arena. Trailing 5-1 after 40 minutes, South Carolina score three goals within the first 8:37 of the 3rd period to cut the Ghost Pirates lead to one, 5-4, before Savannah closed out the game with four straight goals. The nine goals was the most given up by the Stingrays since 12/30/23 in a 9-1 loss to Orlando.

WILKS AT IT AGAIN South Carolina forward Josh Wilkins has picked up where he left off last season with the Stingrays. Through three games this season, Wilkins leads the team in goals with 3 and is tied for second in the ECHL at that mark. His five points through three games leads all Stingrays. The Providence product has two-straight multi-point nights and 44 in his ECHL career.

BACK FOR MOORE Defenseman **Connor Moore** enters his sixth season with the Stingrays following a career year. Last season, the Cumming, GA native had 40 points (10g, 30a) in 65 games. His 10 goals and 40 points were career high's and vs Division..... 1-1-0-0 the most by a Stingrays defensemen last season. Moore has played in 281 games with SC, which is 11th most in franchise history, just surpassing Avalanche HC, Jared Bednar's, 279. What's the Fus(co) About: Defenseman John Fusco has gotten off to a quick start to his professional career. The Westwood, MA native is second on the Stingrays in points with four (1 goal, 3 assists) in three games. Fusco has notched at least a point in every game he's played so far.

> **NEW MAN AT THE HELM** The Stingrays will be under the direction of first year Head Coach, Dave Warsofsky. Warsofsky brings a wealth of knowledge to the Stingrays dressing room after playing in the NHL and AHL and in the Olympic Games for the United States. Warsofsky appeared in 55 games in the NHL and 476 games in the AHL.

DAVID WARSOFSKY

Head Coach | Record: 2-1-0



David Warsofsky is entering his first season as Head Coach and Director of Hockey Operations for the South Carolina Stingrays. He is the 13th head coach in franchise history. Warsofsky joins the Stingrays following a 14-year professional playing career and most recently served as a special coaching advisor for the Stingrays during the 2024-25 season. The Marshfield, Massachusetts native played 55 NHL games with the Boston Bruins, Pittsburgh Penguins, New Jersey Devils, and Colorado Avalanche. He appeared in 476 American Hockey League games with Providence, Wilkes-Barre/Scranton, San Antonio, Chicago, and Colorado. He captained Team USA at the 2008 U18 World Championship, was an assistant captain for the gold medal-winning 2010 U20 World Junior team. He represented Team USA at the 2022 Winter Olympics in Beijing, serving as an assistant captain. Warsofsky helped Boston University win the 2009 NCAA National Championship and was drafted in the 4th round (95th overall) of the 2008 Draft.

SCOTT DAVIDSON

Assistant Coach



Scott Davidson is entering his third season behind the Stingrays bench as an Assistant Coach. In 2023-24, Davidson oversaw the Stingrays forwards and penalty kill. Under Davidson's leadership, South Carolina's penalty kill finished sixth in the ECHL at 82%. Davidson played 33 games as a forward for the Rays during the 2019-20 season. Davidson started his coaching career at the Maine Nordiques Academy in 2021 before coaching at the Elite Hockey Academy in Guilford, Connecticut, this past year. Davidson played four seasons of Division I hockey at Quinnipiac University, where he was an assistant captain in his junior and senior years. Following the conclusion of his collegiate career, Davidson joined the Charlotte Checkers and was a member of their 2019 Calder Cup championship team.

MIKE HAMILTON

Assistant Coach



Mike Hamilton is entering his second season behind the bench with the Stingrays as an assistant coach. Hamilton's playing career lasted six seasons and he skated in 40 games for the Stingrays. He has lived in Charleston for the majority of his post-playing career and is now beginning his professional coaching career. A native of Victoria, British Columbia, Hamilton was selected by the Atlanta Thrashers in the sixth round of the 2003 NHL Draft. Following a four-year college hockey career at the University of Maine from 2003-2007, Hamilton skated in 305 career professional games split between two AHL teams, four ECHL teams, and professional teams in Italy and Scotland. In 2007-08, Hamilton won a Calder Cup Championship with the AHL's Chicago Wolves.

CHUCK LIEBENROOD

Head Equipment Manager

Chuck Liebenrood is entering the second season of his second stint as the Head Equipment Manager for the Stingrays. Liebenrood grew up in Summerville, SC, and attended Stingrays games as a child. He was in attendance at the North Charleston Coliseum the night the Stingrays won their second Kelly Cup title in 2001. Liebenrood played for the Summerville High School hockey team and graduated in 2010. He began working for the Stingrays as an equipment assistant in the 2011-2012 season and was promoted to Head Equipment Manager ahead of the 2014-15 season at age 22. That season, Liebenrood helped the Stingrays reach the 2015 Kelly Cup Finals, where they fell to the Allen Americans in seven games.
