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### KUPKA IS (K)RUISING

Forward Kyler Kupka continues to tear up the ECHL in his second season with South Carolina. The Camrose, Alberta native leads the Stingrays goals (10), assists (11) and points (21). His 10 goals are tied for third in the ECHL and his 21 points are tied for fifth in the league. Kupka has points in six of his last seven games and has multi-point games in five of them.

### LUYPEN LETTING LOOSE

In his first season with the Stingrays, forward Jalen Luypen has become a big addition to the South Carolina offense. Luypen had a four-point (2g, 2a) night last Friday against Greensboro, setting a new single-game career high in points in his professional career. He has nine points (4g, 5a) in his last seven games and is T-12th in points in the ECHL.

### BOHLSSEN ON A ROLL

Forward Kaden Bohlsen has settled in well in his first professional season. The Willmar, MN native has goals in four of his last six games, including the overtime game-winner last Friday against Greensboro, and points in five of his last six. Bohlsen has eight goals and added three assists for 11 points this season. His eight goals are tied for 3rd most among rookies in the ECHL and his three game-winning goals are also tied for the most in the league among rookies.

### POWER PLAY PRODUCTION

The Stingrays powerplay has become a big factor of South Carolina's success this season. SC's PP is working at a 23.6% clip, fifth best in the ECHL. At home this season, the Stingrays are 7/19 (36.8%), the highest rated PP in the ECHL while at home. The Stingrays have scored on the power play in four of the last five games.

### HOME SWEET HOME

The Stingrays return home to the North Charleston Coliseum on Saturday night and play in their first of eight home games in December. The Stingrays are 6-0-0-0 at home this year and the only remaining team undefeated at home this season in the ECHL.

# SOUTH CAROLINA STINGRAYS STAFF

## DAVE WARSOFSKY

**Head Coach | Record: 12-7-1**



David Warsofsky is entering his first season as Head Coach and Director of Hockey Operations for the South Carolina Stingrays. He is the 13th head coach in franchise history. Warsofsky joins the Stingrays following a 14-year professional playing career and most recently served as a special coaching advisor for the Stingrays during the 2024-25 season. The Marshfield, Massachusetts native played 55 NHL games with the Boston Bruins, Pittsburgh Penguins, New Jersey Devils, and Colorado Avalanche. He appeared in 476 American Hockey League games with Providence, Wilkes-Barre/Scranton, San Antonio, Chicago, and Colorado. He captained Team USA at the 2008 U18 World Championship, was an assistant captain for the gold medal-winning 2010 U20 World Junior team. He represented Team USA at the 2022 Winter Olympics in Beijing, serving as an assistant captain. Warsofsky helped Boston University win the 2009 NCAA National Championship and was drafted in the 4th round (95th overall) of the 2008 Draft.

## SCOTT DAVIDSON

**Assistant Coach**



Scott Davidson is entering his third season behind the Stingrays bench as an Assistant Coach. In 2024-25, Davidson oversaw the Stingrays forwards and penalty kill. Under Davidson's leadership, South Carolina's penalty kill finished first in the ECHL at 86.3%. Davidson played 33 games as a forward for the Rays during the 2019-20 season. Davidson started his coaching career at the Maine Nordiques Academy in 2021 before coaching at the Elite Hockey Academy in Guilford, Connecticut, this past year. Davidson played four seasons of Division I hockey at Quinnipiac University, where he was an assistant captain in his junior and senior years. Following the conclusion of his collegiate career, Davidson joined the Charlotte Checkers and was a member of their 2019 Calder Cup championship team.

## MIKE HAMILTON

**Assistant Coach**



Mike Hamilton is entering his second season behind the bench with the Stingrays as an assistant coach. Hamilton's playing career lasted six seasons and he skated in 40 games for the Stingrays. He has lived in Charleston for the majority of his post-playing career and is now beginning his professional coaching career. A native of Victoria, British Columbia, Hamilton was selected by the Atlanta Thrashers in the sixth round of the 2003 NHL Draft. Following a four-year college hockey career at the University of Maine from 2003-2007, Hamilton skated in 305 career professional games split between two AHL teams, four ECHL teams, and professional teams in Italy and Scotland. In 2007-08, Hamilton won a Calder Cup Championship with the AHL's Chicago Wolves.

## CHUCK LIEBENROOD

**Head Equipment Manager**



Chuck Liebenrood is entering the second season of his second stint as the Head Equipment Manager for the Stingrays. Liebenrood grew up in Summerville, SC, and attended Stingrays games as a child. He was in attendance at the North Charleston Coliseum the night the Stingrays won their second Kelly Cup title in 2001. Liebenrood played for the Summerville High School hockey team and graduated in 2010. He began working for the Stingrays as an equipment assistant in the 2011-2012 season and was promoted to Head Equipment Manager ahead of the 2014-15 season at age 22. That season, Liebenrood helped the Stingrays reach the 2015 Kelly Cup Finals, where they fell to the Allen Americans in seven games.

Julia Phillips is entering her second season with the Stingrays. She joins the Rays with experience in both professional and major-junior hockey.
