Walleye Watch

Terrible Tuesday: The Toledo Walleye dropped their first overtime contest on Tuesday morning, losing 5-4 to the Cincinnati Cyclones at Heritage Bank Center. **Denis Smirnov** scored his 4th and 5th goals on the season, including one on the power-play. **Colby Ambrosio** netted his third goal of the year.

Nolan Moyle had a short-handed goal and two points on the day. **Nolan Lalonde** was in net, stopping 16 of 21 shots against him and recording the OTL, moving his record at 4-1-1-0 this season.

Doing it Every Way: Friday was the third time in Walleye history the team scored a goal in each of the five ways possible (even strength, short-handed, power-play, penalty shot, and empty net). Before Friday's game, the Walleye checked all five boxes on 10/27/2012 at Trenton and 1/31/2020 against Kalamazoo. In Cincinnati, **Jordan Ernst** buried a penalty shot goal (Toledo's second such goal of the season), **Tanner Dickinson** scored both on the power-play and on the empty net, **Nate Roy** scored at even strength, and **Will Hillman** added his third short-handed goal (Toledo's league-leading 7th) of the season.

The Mayor Helps Chilly Locals: Toledo's first line with **Brandon Hawkins**, **Chad Hillebrand**, and **Tanner Dickinson** combined for 15 points since last week began. Hawkins has five assists in his last four games, including two primary assists on Saturday. He stands tied for 7th place on the ECHL points leaderboard. Dickinson had 2 two-point games last week and an assist in Tuesday's game, good for 5 points in his last four contests. Hillebrand has five points in his last four games, including the game-winning goal on Saturday and an additional four assists against Cincinnati (two Wednesday, two Friday).

Special Special Teams: Toledo's special teams on both ends of the ice have risen to the occasion as the power play is firing at 29.7% (11-for-37), good for second in the league behind Cincinnati. They also tie for the league's best power play unit away from home, scoring on 8 of 22 opportunities (36.4%). The Walleye remain one of four teams to not allow a power-play goal at home. Additionally, the Fish still hold the league lead for short-handed goals with 8.

The Usual Suspects: **Will Hillman** and **Nolan Moyle** each tied the Walleye single-season record for short-handed goals (3), which has been done 8 times. They became the second pair of Walleye teammates to reach that mark after Sam Craggs and Mitchell Lewandowski did so in the 2023-24 season. Hillman and Moyle share the league lead in short-handed goals. Hillman leads the ECHL in short-handed points (6), Moyle places second (4), and **Nick Andrews** ties for third (3). Andrews has 8 assists on the year (second among ECHL rookies), seven of them coming on special teams (4 PPA, 3 SHA), which is the most among any ECHL rookie.

Brick Walls: Goaltending played a major impact on Toledo's success last week. **Nolan Lalonde** started in the net twice last week, on Wednesday against Cincinnati and against Fort Wayne on Saturday. Between the two games, Lalonde stopped 51 of 54 shots he faced, posting a 2-0-0-0 record and a .944 save percentage. **Liam Soulière** earned his first professional win between the pipes, stopping 20 of the 22 shots he faced (.909 SV%) and recording the win in his first start for the Walleye this season.

This Day in Toledo Hockey History: Announced on Wednesday as one of the new members of the Toledo Hockey Hall of Fame's Class of 2026, Andrew Williamson put on a Hall of Fame performance for the Toledo Storm in 1997. The Storm doubled up the Peoria Rivermen, 4-2, at the Sports Arena behind Williamson, who had a pair of goals, including a shorthanded breakaway effort which gave Toledo a 3-0 lead. "That shorthanded goal was obviously a big key for us," Storm coach and 2019 Toledo Hockey Hall of Famer Greg Puhalski said. "A 2-0 game is obviously far from over, and that third one was a
