TODAY - Wichita returns home today for the first time since November 7 to host Kansas City. Last night, the Thunder fell at the hands of the Mayericks on the road at Cable Dahmer Arena. 1-0. Tonight is the fifth time that the two teams are facing each other in the last eight games. Kansas City leads the season-series, winning three of the first four contests. Wichita will face Kansas City a total of 15 times this year, the most of any opponent. The Mavericks are in second in the Mountain Division with 22 points. The Thunder are tied for sixth with 15. Marcus Crawford leads Kansas City with 21 points. Jackson Jutting is second with 14. Noah Beck leads Wichita with 14 points. Kyle Crnkovic is second with 11.

HEAD-TO-HEAD - This is the fifth meeting of the season between the Thunder and the Mavericks. Alltime, Wichita is 94-81-26 vs. Kansas City and 49-36-10 at home against the Mavericks.

54 - Matt Davis stopped a personal six-game losing skid last Sunday. He made a career high 54 saves for the 2-1 win. Davis stopped 82 of 85 shots in two games last weekend against Toledo and Fort Wayne. He is first in saves (399) and second in minutes played (716).

KANSAS KID - Rvan Finnegan entered last week with two points. He had his first two-goal game of the year last Sunday and added an assist on Friday.

SUN DEVIL - Noah Beck leads the Thunder with 14 points. He has found the scoresheet in six of his last eight and five of his last six games. Beck is tied for the league lead among rookies with 14 points.

300 - Jake Wahlin hit a personal milestone last night. He appeared in his 300th ECHL game. The sixthyear forward needs two goals to reach 50 in his career.

ZEROES - Wichita was shutout last night for the second time this season. In both contests, the Thunder only allowed a combined three goals against.

HOME COOKIN' - Wichita returns home tonight for the first time since November 7. The Thunder will have plenty of home cooking in the next month. Wichita plays eight of the next 12 games at INTRUST Bank Arena. The Thunder will make road trips to Tulsa and Tahoe.
